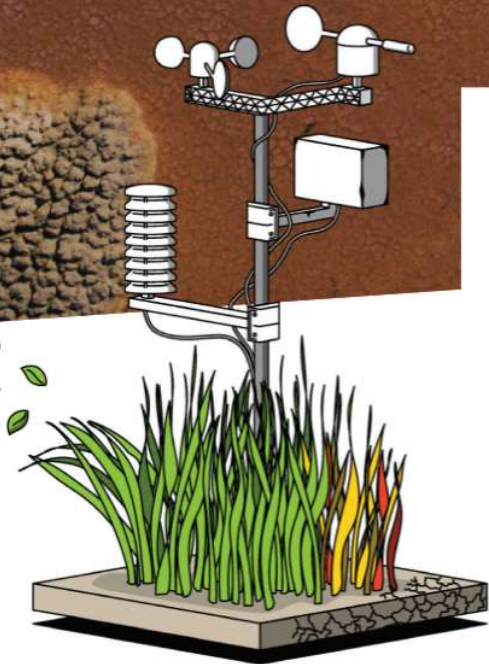

We build ventures over two phases

Aug 2024 – Phase 1

We prepare you and help to validate ideas for commercial success

3 months – 24 Innovators

- Free participation
- \$5k for new venture services
- 1-1 Venture Builder support

2025 – Phase 2

We build a venture together that is commercially viable and investible

Up to 12 months – 4 ventures

- Venture formation, equity design, and IP licensing
- Up to \$250k of non-dilutive support and investment
- Introductions to customers and investors
- 1-1 dedicated Venture Builder support

FAQs

Q. What is the length of the program?

A. Phase One is a 90 day sprint. During Phase Two, successful ventures will receive up to another 12 months of support.

Q. How much equity will you take in my new company?

A. None. Due to our partnership with the Australian Government's Future Drought Fund, the Drought Venture Studio is not currently taking equity in new ventures.

Q. Is there a cost to participate?

A. The Venture Studio is free for selected participants.

Q. What is the weekly time commitment?

A. The time commitment is 1.5 days per week for 12 weeks, with 3.5 hours per week fixed in workshops and sessions.

Q. How developed does my innovation need to be?

A. The Venture Studio does not have a formal requirement for innovation to be developed to a certain stage to be considered.
